Dear Nakayoshi Gakko Families,

Attached please find information for on-line registration for Nakayoshi Gakko's 2018 Summer Session. The session will run for ten full days, starting Monday, June 18, 2018 and ending Friday, June 29, 2018. Online registration will open in January and close in February. Please check the Nakayoshi Gakko website in January. Families will receive an enrollment confirmation email by mid-March.

Nakayoshi Gakko is a Japanese cultural and educational summer program for school-aged children entering grades 1 through 8 in Fall 2018. Classes are held at the Mountain View Buddhist Temple, located at 575 North Shoreline Blvd. in Mountain View.

Nakayoshi Gakko is an independent, non-profit, parent-cooperative school. As a parent co-op, parent participation is crucial. We greatly appreciate and rely upon the time and energy of our parents in order to make our program run efficiently and to create an exceptional experience for the children. **Parents are required to fulfill various volunteer commitments**. These are outlined in the Parent Commitment Requirements Section of this letter. We ask you to please read this section carefully because each family will be expected to fulfill these responsibilities. Please note: All students need to complete on-line registration information and return tuition fees by mail. Family and student information will only be accepted on-line and payments will only be accepted by mail.

All forms and fees must be mailed and postmarked by **February 21**, **2018**. All forms and fees must be mailed to the Registrar at **P.O. Box 390054-0054**. **Mountain View. CA 94039**. All on-line registration and payments postmarked after February 21, 2018, will be given less priority.

Tuition:	 \$450 per child for the two week session. Optional donation of any amount appreciated Please send a \$450 check (per child), payable to "Nakayoshi Gakko" by February 21, 2018 to complete your registration. If we are unable to offer your child a spot, your tuition check will be destroyed. Mail fees to the Registrar at P.O. Box 390054-0054. Mountain View. CA 94039. Extended care fees (see page 5) can be included in the same check (or can be paid up to April 12 if scheduling is not yet certain).
Cancellations:	 Cancellations made and confirmed by the Registrar(s): On or before April 11 will receive a refund less a \$50 processing fee. After April 11 are not refundable.
Priority:	Enrollment priority is given in the following order if the on-line application is completed and payment is postmarked before February 21. 1. Children of current board members 2. Children of NG Teachers 3. Children of past board members 4. Returning students from the 2017 session 5. Siblings of returning students from the 2017 session 6. Mountain View Buddhist Temple members' children 7. Mountain View Buddhist Temple Dharma School students 8. New students who do not qualify for the priorities above (Lottery).
Class Assignments:	Class assignments will be made by Registrars based on the grade of the child in Fall 2018 as indicated on the on-line registration. Parent Commitment Requirements

As a <u>parent-cooperative school</u>, Nakayoshi Gakko relies exclusively on its parent volunteers to support the various school programs and curriculum. Parents are <u>required</u> to assist in four main areas:

- (I) Classroom work,
- (II) Committee support,
- (III) Pre or Post-session maintenance
- (IV) MVBT Obon and Bazaar support.

Inability to fulfill these requirements adversely affects the program and ultimately the students.

Families will be e-mailed links to sign ups for items I, II, III, and IV based on their enrollment priorities. Sign ups will be done using http://www.signupgenius.com.

If a family fails to fulfill their commitments then a fee of \$100 will be assessed and the enrollment priority of the family's returning child(ren) will be lost. The registration of the child(ren) will be considered with the general pool of first-time applicants.

- I. <u>Classroom Work</u>: Parents assist in the classroom <u>one</u> day per family. Work hours are from 8:15 AM to 4:15 PM. On the assigned day, parents may be asked to help teachers prepare class projects, prepare and distribute afternoon snacks, supervise children during snack and lunchtime and to clean up the classroom and other areas. You must be able to serve the whole shift for classroom work. Late arrival or early departure for your duties will adversely affect the children and classroom safety. Please indicate during on-line registration what day you are able to work and for which class.
- II. <u>Committee Support</u>: Each Family serves on <u>one</u> committee. Please indicate during on-line registration your preference for committees.
 - Arts & Crafts Preparation: Prepares materials for classroom projects and special events. Duties may include cutting paper, gluing, woodworking, sewing, etc. Materials are distributed prior to the session starting (generally at parent orientation,) and projects will need to be returned in the morning on the first day of class. Occasionally, projects may need attention during the session, these will require overnight turnaround.
 - Open House (Friday, June 29): Assists in the preparation and execution of Open House. Duties may include pick-up and distribution of obento dinners; set-up and take down of tables, chairs, creation of classroom work display boards; and miscellaneous tasks needed to put on the Open House presentation. Bring dessert to share.
 - <u>Publications</u>: Assist with school newsletter production by observing school activities and writing brief articles; take digital photographs of classes and activities; layout and photocopy. Putting together the photos for a slide show at the Open House.
 - **Fundraising**: Support fund raising activities such as restaurant dinners. Limited to Nakayoshi Gakko treasurers.
- III. <u>Maintenance:</u> A family member works <u>one</u> maintenance day. Please indicate during on-line registration your preference for Maintenance day.
 - Maintenance I: Open School (Saturday, June 16, 9:00 AM-12:00 Noon) Clean classrooms, set up office supplies, restrooms, kitchen, gym, set-up tables and chairs.
 - Maintenance II: Close School (Saturday, June 30, 9:00 AM-12:00 Noon) Clean classrooms, restrooms, kitchen, gym, put away tables and chairs; pack up office supplies.
- IV. MVBT Obon and Bazaar: Work shift to represent Nakayoshi Gakko in the Obon booth on Saturday, July 21, 2018 (4:00 PM-10:00 PM) or Sunday, July 22, 2018 (12:00 Noon-9:00 PM). Sign-ups will be available by the first week of Nakayoshi Gakko session.

All parents are required to attend the **Parents' Orientation Meeting** on May 1, 2018, 7:00 PM-9:00 PM for new families, returning families arrive at 7:30 PM. During this meeting, we will confirm family commitments, distribute the school t-shirts, review school policies, etc. There will also be a brief committee meeting.

Nakayoshi Gakko Extended Care Information

The Extended Care program is designed to meet the needs of the working parents. The program is available only to currently registered students of Nakayoshi Gakko.

Location:	Game Room at the Mountain View Buddhist Temple
Days & Hours:	June 18– June 29, 2018, 4:00 PM-5:30 PM
Registration:	Extended care on-line registration must be completed by April 12, 2018 to ensure a space for your child. Openings will be on a space available basis after that date. Payment may be included with your tuition (due February 21) or up to April 12. Failure to make payment by April 12, 2018 will result in the cancellation of a space for your child in extended care.
Fees:	Fees are \$15 per day per child paid in full by April 12. After April 12 and prior to June 18, fees are \$20 per day, per child, subject to availability. Emergency or unscheduled use of extended care is subject to availability and will be billed at \$20 per day. Mail fees to Registrar at P.O. Box 390054-0054. Mountain View. CA 94039. If in a separate check after February 21, please indicate in notes that this is for extended care.
Refunds:	Payment is fully refundable until April 12. No refunds will be given for cancellations made after that date. Unused extended care is not refundable.
Late Fee:	The facility closes promptly at 5:30 PM. There is a five-minute grace period. Starting at 5:35 PM a late charge of \$5.00 per minute is assessed.
Procedures:	Children registered for extended care will be walked from the gym to the Game Room at 4:00 PM. after the cultural demonstration finishes. A sign-out sheet must be signed by a parent or authorized person for pick up.
