Welcome to Nakayoshi Gakko! We are SO excited and looking forward to meeting and working with your child in person this summer. We have two weeks planned full of fun activities where your child will learn about various and unique aspects of Japanese culture.

Please read through the following information **before** the first day of class on Monday, June 19th, 2023. It will give you a chance to collect the items that your child will need for the program.

**A and B** can be either:

- 3) brought to school no later than the first day of school June 19th.

**A) Your Family Mon-**

It would be very helpful if your mon is blown up and printed on an **8 ½ x 11 sheet of white paper**. The mon should be at least 6"-8" wide and fill as much of the page as possible. It should be a bold, clear image. We will be photocopying their mon and shrinking it to a smaller image. Please be sure to label the mon with your child's name.

**B) Family Tree information-** Please provide information for a family tree project. We would like your child's name, their sibling(s) names, their parents' names (**include maiden names**), and their maternal and paternal grandparents' name. For **example**, for my daughter Lacey, the information I would provide would be:

brother: Blake Yasahiro Armistead

**Mama:** Marilyn Shigeko **Higa**

**Daddy:** Robert Ashby Armistead III

maternal grandparents: **Grandma:** Jean Hisako **Ishii**

**Papa:** Jitsuo Higa

paternal grandparents: **Nana:** Mona Carole **Thornhill**

**Bopa:** Robert Ashby Armistead Jr.

**Be sure to put down names your child calls each member (Mom, Mommy, Mama etc.) which makes it more personal.**

**C) Please bring a plain white cotton t-shirt (pre-washed) that fits your child**

**D) Other Supplies-** Please have your child bring the following items in a small box or container that is labeled with your child's name. The container will stay in the classroom for the duration of the program.

- bottle of wet glue (small size)
- scissors (child size)
- fine tip black sharpie
- 2 glue sticks (not purple)
- pencils and erasers
- crayons or colored pencils
- package of wet wipes
- small bottle of personal hand sanitizer
